In our 8th year, 2010 brings more change to **Fiber on the Foot**. We are beginning our 3rd year as a multi species natural fiber event. We are now, ***Fiber on the Foot, Natural Fiber Producer's Livestock Show and Fiber Festival.***

All natural fiber producers are welcome to participate and to sell their products, livestock and guardian dogs.

RV reservations

Fees:

Pens **\$20** each, (for 2 days) minimum size 8 X 8, includes farm listing in program and on website

Fiber Arts building vendor spaces are **\$35** (for two days) 10x10 minimum

Own (static) page on Fiber on the Foot site **\$40** (+ design fees if required, fee payable to web designer)

Sponsorship Minimums:

Sponsor a Barn \$120 a day (4 available) Sponsor receives 2 free pens, priority pen placement, may hang their banner in the center of the barn and sponsorship will be announced throughout the day.

Sponsor Fiber Building \$225 a day, (2 available) Sponsor receives 2 free spaces, priority space placement, may hang their banner at entrance to the building and sponsorship will be announced throughout the day. And will have name published in local press releases. Sponsorship includes link to personal site and listing on Sponsor's page on FotF site and on program.

Barn Guidelines:

- * **Livestock owners are responsible for providing their own Bio-Security.**
- ** **Barn Floors are concrete (some dirt). Owners are responsible for providing own bedding and clean up of pens.**
- *** **Pens may be used as farm store or livestock pens.**

Fiber competitions:

There will be an educational **non-sanctioned** fiber competition "on the foot". Each class will begin with a short presentation about the breed explaining what makes them unique as fiber livestock. All species may be divided by light and dark classes and provided the appropriate showing, "On the Foot". **We can produce a fleece show (in the bag) if we get 100 fleeces committed.**

Demonstrations and Presentations:

The success of our event depends on cooperation of participating farms. This includes performing demonstrations and giving educational presentations. Let Irene know which talks you would like to present. 530-527-5180

Classes: All class fees are collected by and go to the instructors. Classes will be posted on the website and in the program. Contact Irene to sign-up to teach and to schedule your class time. 530-527-5180. Classes need posted to the site by March 1st.
